

A Brain to Skype Interface for people with severe disabilities.

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Skype is a popular Internet communication software application that provides access to phone calling (to online as well as fixed and mobile numbers), SMS messaging, text chatting, video conferencing, and receiving phone calls using the online number feature. Skype is used by millions of people (more than 500 million registered users) around the world for both business and casual communication. However, this technology is not accessible to people with severe disabilities. In this workshop we will research a novel brain computer interface that allows people with disabilities to communicate using Skype chat.
